Completion Air Tightness Testing

All building warrants granted in Scotland from the **1st of February 2023** will require completion Air Tightness Testing to be carried out in every plot within residential and commercial developments.

How to comply with the new Building Regulations (Scotland)

Developers, Architects, and Builders in Scotland will be required to organise Air Tightness Testing for their newly completed developments with an accredited tester. RMP engineers are accredited for testing through the UK wide approved third-party certification scheme operated by Elmhurst Airtightness Scheme (EAS), ensuring testing and reporting are in-line with all regulatory requirements
